Dr. John Beaumier of Cedar River, a parishioner of St. Joseph & St. Patrick Parish in Escanaba, was surprised and honored to receive the first Catholic Service Award at the annual Bishop's Ambassadors Dinner of the Catholic Diocese of Marquette on October 6, 2007 in Marquette.

The award recognizes lifetime dedication and service to the diocesan church. It was developed as part of the Legacy of Faith diocesan endowment campaign. The award was presented by Bishop Emeritus James H. Garland, who initiated the Legacy of Faith campaign in 2001 to establish a permanent endowment foundation with the mission of preserving and fostering the Catholic faith in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.
