- 1**
- Opening prayer-- discuss and explain the meanings of these words.
 - Who is the creator of all things? (God)
 - Pledge of Allegiance.
 - Recite the alphabet.
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- 2**
- How many letters in the alphabet? (26)
 - What are the two size sizes of letters? (uppercase and lowercase)
 - What are the two types of letters? (vowels and consonants)
 - What is the Bible? (The Bible is God's word. The Bible teaches us about God's love.)
 - Recite the golden rule. (Do unto others as you would have them do unto you. Mt 7:12)
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- 3**
- How many vowels are there? (5) Name the vowels? (a, e, i, o, u)
 - What are the short vowel sounds? (**a** (apple) **e** (egg), **i** (igloo), **o** (octopus), **u** (umbrella))
 - Count to 20 by 1s.
 - Recite Genesis 1:1, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."
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- 4**
- Recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Once mastered say pledge the Pledge of Allegiance after prayer and before phonics questions.
 - Recite Genesis 1:27, "God created man in his image."
 - Recite the first memorized poem. (chorally)
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- 5**
- What letter do you add to a word to make it plural? (S)
 - How are all people made? (All people are made in the image of God.)
 - Why did God make us? (God made us to know, love, and serve him and to be happy in heaven.)
 - How many days are in the week? (7)
 - Name the days of the week in order. (Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday)
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- 6**
- Name the four directions. (North, South, East, West) Point to the four directions.
 - Count to 30 by 1s
 - Recite Psalm 8:2, "O Lord, our Lord, how awesome is your name over all the earth! You have set your majesty above the heavens!"
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- 7**
- How many seasons are there? (4)
 - Name the four seasons. (fall, winter, spring, summer)
 - Recite the second memorized poem. (chorally)
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- 8**
- How many months are in the year? (12)
 - Name the first six months in order. (January, February, March, April, May, June)
 - Name one way we can experience God's love. (We can experience God's love through love of others such as our family and friends.)
 - Recite Psalm 115:15, "May you be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth."
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- 9
- What State do we live in? (Michigan)
 - Name the second six months of the year in order. (July, August, September, October, November, December)
 - Recite Isaiah 11:1-2, “But a shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots a bud shall blossom.”

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- 10
- What country do we live in? (United States)
 - On what continent do you live? (North America)
 - In which month is Thanksgiving? (November)
 - Recite Matthew 5:43-44, “You have heard that it was said, ‘you shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy’. But I say to you, love your enemies.”

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- 11
- Count to 50 by 1s
 - Count to 100 by 10s
 - Count to 50 by 5s
 - Recite the third memorized poem.

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- 12
- Who is Jesus’s mother? (Mary)
 - What does Christmas celebrate? (Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus our Savior.)
 - In which month is Christmas? (December)
 - Recite Luke 2:11, “For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord.”

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- 13
- Name all 12 months in order. (January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December)
 - Recite John 3:16, “For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”

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- 14
- How many continents are there? (7)
 - Name the seven continents. (North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Antarctica, Australia)

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- 15
- Count to 50 by 2s
 - What do the stories that Jesus told us in the bible mean? (In the stories Jesus told show us about God’s love and that we are to love God and others.)
 - How many pennies are in a nickel? (5)
 - How many pennies are in a dime? (10)
 - How many pennies are in a quarter? (25)
 - How many pennies are in a dollar? (100)

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- 16
- What is the fourth commandment? (Honor your father and mother)
 - Recite the fourth memorized poem.
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- 17
- On what planet do you live? (Earth)
 - How many planets are there? (8 – Pluto was downgraded)
 - Recite Luke 6:19, “Everyone in the crowd sought to touch him because power came forth from him and healed them all.”
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- 18
- What do I say when I’ve been unkind to others? (I say, “I’m sorry”)
 - Count to 100 by 5s
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- 19
- How many nickels are in a dollar? (20)
 - How many dimes are in a dollar? (10)
 - How many quarters are in a dollar? (4)
 - Recite Matthew 6:21, “For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.”
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- 20
- What is the Holy Eucharist? (The Holy Eucharist is the body and blood of Jesus.)
 - How many days are in a year? (365)
 - How many hours in a day? (24)
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- 21
- Who was the first president? (George Washington)
 - What do we call the angel who watches over us? (Our guardian angel)
 - How many states are in your country? (50)
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- 22
- How many stars are on the American flag? (50)
 - How many stripes are on the American flag? (13)
 - How many seconds are in a minute? (60)
 - How many minutes are in an hour? (60)
 - Recite the Angel of God prayer.
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- 23
- Recite Matthew 16:18, “And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.”
 - Recite the fifth memorized poem.
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- 24
- What is the capital city of our state? (Lansing)
 - What is the capital of our country? (Washington D.C.)
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- 25
- What does Easter celebrate? (Easter is the celebration of Jesus’s resurrection from the dead.)
 - What are the two parts of the Bible? (Old Testament and New Testament)
 - Name the four Gospels. (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John)
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- 26
- Count to 100 by 2s
 - How many oceans are there in the world? (5 – Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Arctic, and Southern)
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- 27
- What are the long vowel sounds? (**a** (cane) **e** (pea) **i** (ice) **o** (note) **u** (unicorn))
 - Recite Galatians 5:25, “If we live in the Spirit, let us also follow the Spirit.”
 - Recite the sixth memorized poem chorally.
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
